KINDERGARTEN

Dear Parents,

Welcome to KCES Kindergarten! iBienvenidos al kinder! We anticipate a great year as we work together with you and the precious children that God has entrusted to your care.

We are so excited to see you in August! Please note that **both** 3 day kindergarteners and 5 day kindergarteners will attend school on the first day, Tuesday, August 23rd. This is a half-day of school with dismissal at 11:40.

There are a few things that your child will need to bring to school:

- 1. One pencil box (Standard size 8x5x2). Please label with your child's name.
- A pair of scissors with your child's name on it.
- 3. Glue sticks. We use these often so please send in at least 24.
- 4. A backpack that is big enough to carry our note bags and books home.
- 5. An art shirt with your child's name printed clearly on the front. Please put your name on the front, so the art teacher can easily read the name. An old t-shirt is the easiest for a child to get on and off.
- 6. Children need two pairs of shoes. An outdoor pair for wearing to and from school and on the playground; and an indoor pair for the classroom and gym. The indoor pair will remain at school. Please make sure the indoor shoes are tennis shoes since they will be using them for gym class.
- 7. A one-inch 3-ring binder with your child's name on the side.
- 8. A pair of headphones in a large ziploc plastic bag with your child's name on it. (Please do not send earbuds.)
- 9. Three containers of antibacterial wipes
- 10. Two boxes of markers (10 count, either thick or thin)
- 11. One box of colored pencils (12 count)
- 12. One box of crayons (24 pack)

Please make sure your child's name is on all articles of clothing that could be removed. Erasers and pencils are provided by the school. Please keep supplies separate in their original containers. We will organize these in the classroom.

We thank God for the opportunity He has given us to serve Him as teachers. We know that it is only in His strength that we can do the task. We are praying for you and your children and we ask that you remember us in your prayers. See you soon!

1ST GRADE



Dear Families,

We are happy to be teaching your child in first grade and we are looking forward to working with you this year. We, as teachers, will work hard to give each of the children many successful experiences and challenges in first grade. We will do our best to make sure your child is safe, loved and educated. It is truly an honor to develop and nurture these precious gifts of God.

Your child should bring the following items to school to the open house on Monday, August 22 between 4:30 and 6:30, (so we can be ready for our first day on August 23!):

crayons

Crayola markers
a large eraser
glue sticks
a scissors

5 regular sized **pencils** (sharpened)

a plastic **box** to keep supplies in (crayons, markers, etc.)

a 2-pocket **folder** (for papers we are still working on.)

3-ring <u>binders</u> – 1 inch size for our collection of poems & writings (2 for English, 1 for Spanish Immersion)

2 packages of baby wipes or Clorox wipes to share (for wiping desks)

headphones (for your child's personal use with the iPad, please test for a good fit.)

a pair of **gym shoes** (indoor shoes) to keep at school (see note below)

an art shirt (an old large shirt is fine) - can be folded and put in top of locker

A **Beach towel** to keep in your locker to sit on when learning outside.

**Please <u>label</u> your child's things with his or her name, as things get misplaced often.

Indoor shoes explanation: Since most of our school is carpeted, to prevent excess wear on the carpet, we ask that the children bring two sets of shoes to school. One pair (indoor shoes) will be kept at school to wear inside (including gym class.) The other pair (the ones they wear to school in the morning) will be used for outside play and also to wear home. Indoor shoes don't have to be new, just clean. We appreciate your support.

We would appreciate your prayers as we prepare for the new school year. We are excited to meet you and your children. We know this will be a different kind of year - but we are looking forward to partnering with you and sharing God's love with your children.
